## visitor guidelines

To enhance the safety of our patients, families and team members, Riley Hospital for Children will follow the below visitor guidelines for inpatient units year-round. Seasonal restrictions may be in place. Please speak with a member of your care team to get the most current information and to help answer any questions.

Simon Family Tower	Medical/Surgical including Hematology & Oncology, Stem Cell, Solid Organ Transplant and Heart Center	Siblings under 18 years old allowed with an adult.	4 adults
	Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU)	Siblings 4 to 18 years old allowed with an adult. No visitors under 4 years old.	2 adults
	Cardiovascular Intensive Care Unit (CVICU)	Siblings 4 to 18 years old allowed with an adult. No visitors under 4 years old.	2 adults
	Burn	Siblings under 18 years old allowed with an adult for non-ICU level patient. No visitors under 4 years old for ICU level patient.	2 adults for ICU patient 4 adults for non-ICU patient
	Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU)	Siblings 4 to 18 years old allowed with an adult. No visitors under 4 years old.	2 adults
Maternity Tower	OB Emergency Department	No visitors under 18 years old.	1 support person
	Labor & Delivery	Siblings under 18 years old allowed with an adult.	4 support people
	Post-partum	Siblings under 18 years old allowed with an adult.	4 support people
	Intensive Care Unit (ICU)	Siblings under 18 years old allowed with an adult.	2 support people
	Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU)	Siblings 4 to 18 years old allowed with an adult. No visitors under 4 years old.	2 adults

### Overnight guidelines

Hospital location	Visitor age restriction <sup>1,2</sup>	Maximum adults allowed in room (18 or older) <sup>3</sup>
Simon Family Tower	No visitors under 18 years old. Parent, guardian or designee only.	2 adults
Maternity Tower	No visitors under 18 years old.	2 adults for NICU; 4 support people for Labor & Delivery

<sup>1</sup> The number of siblings in the room is not limited unless specified by your unit or care team. A sibling is considered any individual under 18 years old (related or unrelated) living in the same household as the patient.

<sup>2</sup> Exceptions may be made on a case-by-case basis by the care team for situations such as the parent of a patient exclusively breastfeeding, end-of-life, or the parent of a patient is under 18 years old.

<sup>3</sup> A values-based decision by nursing will be supported if additional visitor restrictions are needed when clinical care cannot properly be delivered.
