¹ The number of siblings in the room is not limited unless specified by your unit or care team. A sibling is considered any individual under 18 years old (related or unrelated) living in the same household as the patient.

³ A values-based decision by nursing will be supported if additional visitor restrictions are needed when clinical care cannot properly be delivered.
